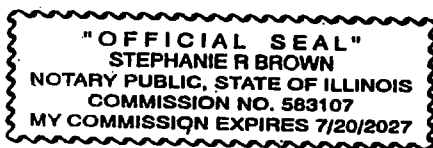
RESISTING OR OBSTRUCTING A PEACE OFFICER
