PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

I Deputy Todd [REDACTED], being an officer of the Carroll County Sheriff's Office states that Paul C. Little [REDACTED] was arrested for the offense of Resisting or obstructing a peace officer on the 11 of May, 2024 at approximately 1605 hrs and states that the arrest was based upon the following:

[REDACTED] came to this officer to report that Matthew C. Little had bitten their son, [REDACTED] a minor child 2 years of age, on the right hand side of his face. [REDACTED] advised that she wished to sign a complaint against Matthew for domestic battery. I went out to her address of [REDACTED] Scenic Palisades Rd to speak with the child's father Matthew C. Little. After arriving at the address above. Paul C. Little opened the door of the residence and after telling him I was there to speak with Matthew C. Little about a domestic violence against a minor child that happened earlier in the day. Paul advised that Matthew was currently in the residence. After arguing with me briefly, he shut the door in my face and told me to get a warrant. He turned to run after being told he was going to get arrested for obstructing. He fought deputies until his hands were behind his back and was taken into custody.
