PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

I Deputy Todd, being an officer of the Carroll County Sheriff's Office states that Matthew C. Little was arrested for the offense of Domestic Battery - Bodily Harm on the 11 of May, 2024 at approximately 1628 hrs and states that the arrest was based upon the following:

[REDACTED] came to this officer to report that Matthew C. Little had bitten their son, [REDACTED] a minor child 2 years of age, on the right hand side of his face. I observed what looked like a human type bite on the side of his face. [REDACTED] advised that she wished to sign a complaint against Matthew for domestic battery. I went out to her address of [REDACTED] Scenic Palisades Rd to speak with the child's father Matthew C. Little. Upon speaking with Matthew he admitted to biting [REDACTED] and that he felt it was excessive. Matthew admitted this was a punishment for [REDACTED] for crying and not wanting to wear pants that morning.
