## AMENDED INFORMATION

The State's Attorney of Whiteside County, Illinois charges:

COUNT 1 - (0735100)

### Class M

That on or about the 14th day of February, 2025, in Whiteside County, Illinois, KYLE M. COOPER committed the offense of 1ST DEGREE MURDER in violation of Act 5, Section 9-1(a)(2), Chapter 720, Illinois Compiled Statutes, in that said defendant, without lawful justification, utilizing a bladed instrument, repeatedly stabbed the abdomen of Daniel J. Gordon, knowing that said act created a strong probability of the death or great bodily harm to Daniel J. Gordon.

COUNT 2 - (0016122)

### Class 3

That on or about the 14th day of February, 2025, in Whiteside County, Illinois, KYLE M. COOPER committed the offense of AGGRAVATED BATTERY in violation of Act 5, Section 12-3.05(f)(1), Chapter 720, Illinois Compiled Statutes, in that said defendant in committing a battery, in violation of Act 5, Section 12-3, Chapter 720, Illinois Compiled Statutes, without legal justification and by use of a deadly weapon, a bladed instrument, knowingly caused bodily harm to Daniel J. Gordon in that said defendant repeatedly stabbed the abdomen of Daniel J. Gordon.


COUNT 3 - (0016094)

Class 3

That on or about the 14th day of February, 2025, in Whiteside County, Illinois, KYLE M. COOPER committed the offense of AGGRAVATED BATTERY in violation of Act 5, Section 12-3.05(a)(1), Chapter 720, Illinois Compiled Statutes, in that said defendant in committing a battery, in violation of Act 5, Section 12-3, Chapter 720, Illinois Compiled Statutes, without legal justification, knowingly caused great bodily harm to Daniel J. Gordon, in that he repeatedly struck the abdomen of Daniel J. Gordon and in doing so caused great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement.


